#### 2020 SILVER WAVE ONLINE EXPERIENCE

Here are a couple of definitions for terms you will see frequently on the Eventive platform:

Video-on-demand (VOD) - Content can be viewed at anytime. Flexible viewing like Netflix.

The festival will also hold an industry series comprising of various 'In Conversations', an Awards Ceremony and other film industry sessions. These will be livestreamed at specific times and made available as VOD afterwards.



Willis was never able to catch a break outside of Vermont, but when the word got around that he was diagnosed with cancer and he needed help, his fans and friends came out of the woodwork to support him as he headlined his own benefit show. When You Are Wild is a heart-felt music film that shows a community supporting one of its own when support is most needed.




